HOW TO: Connect the QR Code Scanner

Connect using **USB Dongle:**

The **USB dongle** is plugged into the back of the point of sale unit. Make sure the number on the dongle matches the number on your scanner!

Pull the trigger once to wake up the scanner. Then scan the codes below in order. Listen for a beep after each scan!



Connect using **USB Cable:**

Plug the scanner into a full size point of sale unit using the **USB cable** to charge; it can be used to scan while charging.

Pull the trigger once to wake up the scanner. Then scan the codes below in order. Listen for a beep after each scan!

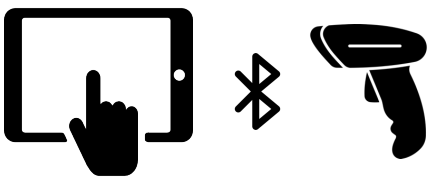


Important: only use a computer USB port or a special 5V DC power adapter to charge, otherwise damage to the scanner and battery will occur!

Connect using **Bluetooth:**

Connect the scanner via **bluetooth** to a phone or tablet to scan tickets and sign waivers/tech cards on your device.

Pull the trigger once to wake up the scanner. Then scan the codes below in order. Listen for a beep after each scan!



4: Hold down the trigger for 8 seconds until you hear a beep. It has now entered Bluetooth search mode, which is indicated by a flashing blue/green light.

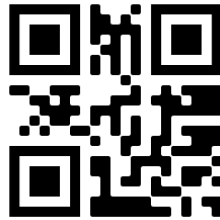
5: On your device (phone/tablet)
iOS: Go to Settings > Bluetooth
Android: Go to Settings > Connected devices
Select "Barcode Scanner HID"

6: Listen for beep. The scanner will beep and the blue/green lights will change to solid (not flashing) once paired.



Advanced Scanner Setup

Check Battery Life:



Put your cursor in a text box or somewhere else you could type and view text.

Scan this code to see the battery life of your scanner. It will display on the screen where your cursor was.

Continuous Scanning:



self-sensing scanning mode

This setting will allow the scanner to continually scan without having to press the trigger. This is usually used when placed in the stand.

Make sure you also set automatic power off setting to NEVER and have the scanner plugged in charging via USB cable.

Manual Scanning:



manual Trigger mode

This setting will set your scanner to manually scan barcodes after each trigger pull.

Automatic Power Off Settings:



5 minutes



30 minutes



Never
